



Ayumi Konishi, Deputy Director General, Pacific Department, Asian Development Bank

Mr. Ayumi Konishi, is a career international civil servant with 30 years of experience. He joined the United Nations secretariat in 1982 as an Economic Affairs Officer and first assigned to the Economic Commission for Western Asia in Baghdad, Iraq. He then served for the UN Headquarters in New York and for the Economic Commission for Africa in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia before joining ADB in 1988.

In ADB, he was first assigned to Programs Department (East), Division 3, which covered Papua New Guinea and the South Pacific, and then served as Project Economist with Education Division since 1989. During the Asian Economic Crisis, he led the team to process \$500 million rescue loan for Thailand, and then served as the principal desk officer for Indonesia in 1998 and 1999. He became Programs Manager for Programs Department (East) Division 2 in January 2000, then with the reorganization, changed his role to be Director, Governance, Finance and Trade Division of the Southeast Asia Department in 2002. Subsequently, he served as ADB's Country Director for Viet Nam between April 2006 and June 2011, and as Senior Advisor, Strategy Policy Department between July and February 2012.

With two undergraduate degrees one from Waseda University in Japan and Oregon State University in US, he did his postgraduate studies in New York University, US.
