Government's direction for SOE reform


- Previously
 - Privatization, Improving Governance, Downsizing, Debt Management
- Incumbent Government(2013~)
 - Debt Management
 - 18 institutions flagged as "highly indebted"
 - Goal : to lower the debt ration to 200% by 2017

Korea Expressway corporation

- Function
 - Build and operate express highways in Korea : 4,044 kilometer
- Construction resources
 - 40% Government + 60% KEC fund
- Financial status
 - Debt : 25.3 trillion won
 - Cost compensation ratio: 82%
- Plan for debt reduction: 1.9 trillion won by 2017
 - through selling rest stations, deferring unprofitable roads

Korea Expressway corporation

- PPP road projects : Orange and Red
 - 791 kilometer
- Since 2006, KEC started to invest in PPP road projects
 - Third sector project: SOE + PPP company
 - Maintains 3 road projects: 147 kilometer



SOE and PPP cooperation

- < Rationale for cooperation>
- 1. KEC's participation signals the project's credibility and stabilisty
- 2. May reduce excessive construction cost solicited by PPP company, as KEC offers consultancy during construction period of PPP project
- 3. May lower the overall cost of road maintenance
- Average distance of Expressway by KEC : 74 kilometer
- Average distance of Expressway by PPP: 39 kilometer
- -> Road maintenance cost can be considerably reduced if KEC maintains
