Handbook

Handbook Securities Statistics

- Working Group on Securities Databases kept working to fulfil mandate
- BIS drafted Part 1, ECB Parts 2 and 3, and IMF provided important technical support
- The three parts are to be consolidated into one single Handbook on Securities Statistics

Part 1: Debt Securities Issues

Features

- Publication May 2009
- Breakdowns
 - Issuing sector.
 - Market
 - Maturity
 - Interest rate
- Q frequency; timeliness= T+3 months
- Importance metadata

Process

- Data by central banks are stored in BIS Data Bank
- Major exercise for contributing central banks and the BIS
- Focus on non-euro area
 G-20 countries
- Euro Area covered by ESCB's Securities Issues

Implementation

- ECB deals with EU central banks in ESCB Statistics Committee
- Implementation ESA 2010 in 2014 – fully in line with HSS
- Use ESCB's CSDB → replace ECB Guideline on Securities Issues

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Implementation Part 1 HSS (I)

Reporting and Publication

 Reporting and publication will evolve stepwise – as described in BIS note -

Improved data reporting

Enhanced publication

 BIS to revise the data collection & reporting of debt securities data to align definitions and breakdowns to the HSS

 Enhanced publication tables showing the stocks and flows of debt securities following the HSS

Part 2: Debt Securities Holdings

- Publication Sep 2010
- Extends sectoral breakdown Part 1 HSS
- From-whom-to-whom framework between sectors
- Supports Coordinated Portfolio Investment Survey data collection IMF
- Required breakdowns debt securities holdings may evolve stepwise

Part 3 of HSS

Part 3: Equity Securities

- Covers issues and holdings of equity securities (listed and unlisted shares)
- ECB is leading institution drafting this part in coordination with BIS and IMF
- Drafting started in Feb 2011
- Review Group met at IMF mid-Oct 2011
- Published 28 Nov 2012

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
