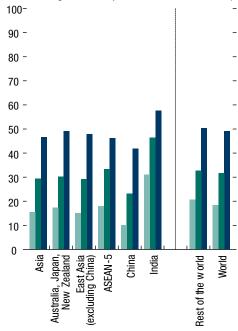
Figure 1.7.1. Share of Services Exports in Trade, 2011

- Services in gross exports (value-added terms, including services inputs in merchandise sectors)

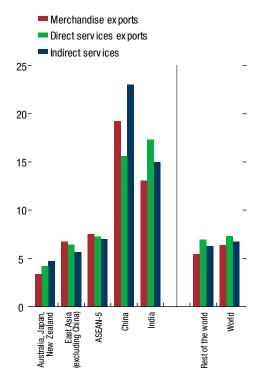

Figure 1.7.2. Annual Average Growth in Domestic Value-Added Content in Exports, 1995-2011

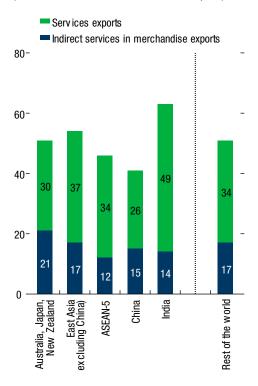

(Percent of total domestic value added in exports)



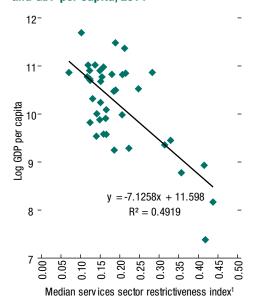
