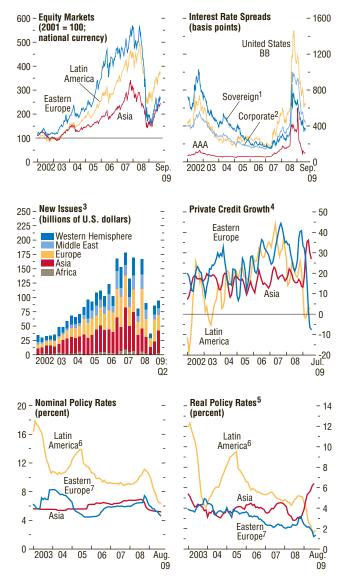
Figure 1.4. Emerging Market Conditions
