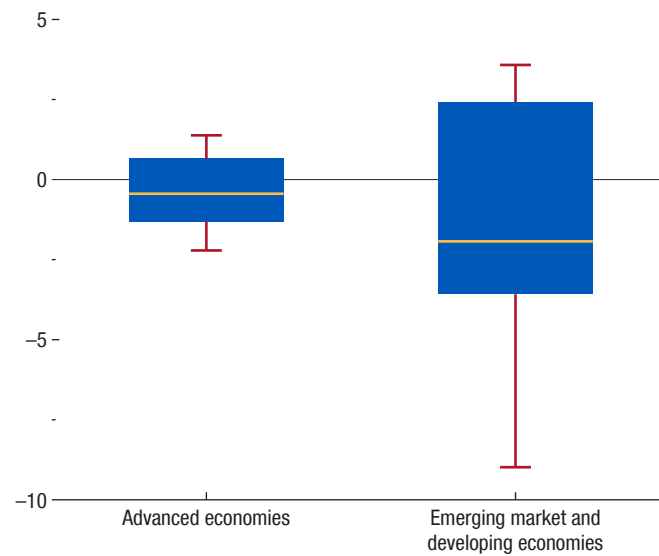


**Figure 3.3. Distribution of Estimated Trends in Labor Shares, 1991–2014**
