

Documenting and quantifying macroeconomic and specific fiscal risks.

Kenya

Comprehensive fiscal risk statement Includes sensitivity analysis Quantification of some specific risks

Uganda

First fiscal risk statement in 2016-17 Updated yearly, and contains sensitivity analysis.

<u>Tanzania</u>

Initial fiscal risk statement in 2015-16

<u>Malawi</u>

Draft fiscal risk statement in 2018-19

EAC

Produced an agreed template for EAC fiscal risk statements in 2016














Example of forecast variance analysis



Real GDP growth forecast and outcome
















Example of confidence intervals



Revenue / GDP forecast with confidence intervals








