- Incomplete application forms or applications missing required documents will not be processed. Please note that submitted documents will not be returned, and application materials are not held over to the following year, in the event that an applicant seeks to reapply for a scholarship.
- If selected, applicants must submit original copies of their application materials requested by the university of enrollment for their admission process. Failure to do so will result in the revocation of the university's admission and cancellation of the scholarship offer.
- When taking an English proficiency examination (TOEFL or IELTS), applicants are requested/required to register with the institution code of the JISPA.<sup>2</sup>

- 4. Official Diploma or Degree Certificates:** As described in the Application Guidelines. Official English translations are required if the original documents are not in English. Each translation must be attached to the original document.
- 5. Official Transcripts:** As described in the Application Guidelines. Official English translations are required if the original documents are not in English. Each translation must be attached to the original document.
- 6. Grading System and GPA Explanation:** Include the page from the transcript or a separate document that explains the grading system and GPA. If not provided, applicants must prepare an explanation and calculate their GPA using a GPA calculator, attaching the completed calculator.
- 7. TOEFL Score Record or IELTS Test Report**  
If the institution code was not registered when taking the test, the original score report must be submitted. Applicants from India, the Philippines, and selected Pacific Island countries are exempt.
- 8. Photo:** A recent photo in JPG format, maximum size 500KB.

#### **PASSPORT COPY**

A scanned copy of the photo page of your valid national passport must be submitted separately via email. Refer to the Application Guidelines for detailed instructions.

#### **REFERENCE LETTERS**

Two letters of reference: As described in the Application Guidelines. Referees must submit the letters directly through the online reference system.
