Research Analyst

IMF Regional Office for Asia and the Pacific (OAP) in Tokyo

The International Monetary Fund's Regional Office for Asia and the Pacific (OAP) in Tokyo is looking for a locally recruited Research Analyst to support OAP's economic and financial monitoring, outreach, and seminar activities in Japan and other Asian countries.

Main tasks will be collecting and analyzing economic data, maintaining databases, and creating presentations on OAP's analytical work. Opportunities to participate in economic research may also arise.

Necessary qualifications include the following: familiarity with macroeconomic and statistical concepts and indicators; knowledge of economic data sources and databases; a strong affinity for working with data; proficiency in Excel, data management, and presentation software; excellent written and spoken English skills; accuracy and attention to detail; and ability to work in a team as well as independently. Exposure to significant and current or recent training in macro- and international economics at graduate level or as a PhD candidate, knowledge of econometrics and related software packages, familiarity with gen-AI tools, and some knowledge of Japanese would be strong additional assets.

The position would be part-time, on an hourly basis, and would initially be for six months. After successful completion of the initial period, a renewable contract could be offered. The salary would be commensurate with background and experience.
