Individuals may submit an appeal to the IMF Data Privacy Appeals Committee if they are not satisfied with the IMF Data Privacy Function's decision regarding their complaint.

The IMF Data Privacy Appeals Committee is an independent, interdepartmental body comprised of management-level staff, and it operates separately from the Data Privacy Appeals Committee.

To respond more promptly and precisely to your appeal, the IMF Data Privacy Appeals Committee needs certain preliminary information to be provided within the request. Therefore, please complete the form below. All fields in this form are mandatory, as applicable. The information provided in this form will be used for handling your appeal. EXPLANATORY NOTES

The appeal process is comprised of three phases:

Phase 1: Submit appeal form to the IMF Data Privacy Appeals Committee

• Provide your details and (if applicable) details of your authorized representative.

State your appeal request.

Time considerations: You will need to submit your appeal within 30 calendar days of:

- Receiving the decision of the IMF Data Privacy Function regarding your complaint, OR
- If no decision was issued by the IMF Data Privacy Function within the required timeframe (i.e., within 30 calendar days unless they notified you that they need an additional 30 days due to the complexity of your complaint or overall number of submissions that they are dealing with.)

Phase 2: The IMF Data Privacy Appeals Committee may ask for additional information to help process your appeal

- The IMF Data Privacy Appeals Committee may ask you or your authorised representative for supporting documents to verify your identity or the authority of the authorised representative (if any).
- The IMF Data Privacy Appeals Committee may ask for clarification in cases where the appeal seems unclear or unspecific. Please promptly provide additional information requested by the IMF Data Privacy Appeals Committee to enable the processing of your appeal.

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Phase 3: Processing of appeal and response

- The IMF Data Privacy Appeals Committee will acknowledge receipt of your appeal and will respond in writing and in English to the appellant or its authorised representative (if any). The Data Privacy Appeals Committee will review and issue a decision on your appeal within 90 calendar days. The written decision of the Data Privacy Appeals Committee will be sent to you by the same method that you used to make your submission to the Data Privacy Appeals Committee.
- The IMF Data Privacy Appeals Committee may refuse appeals as outlined in the Privacy Notice stating the reasons.
