# Work Program Implementation

**54 Activities Delivered (May - December 2024)**

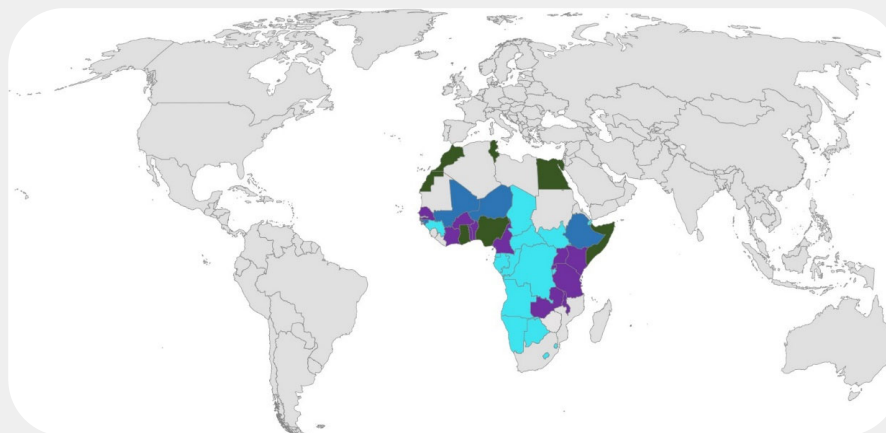
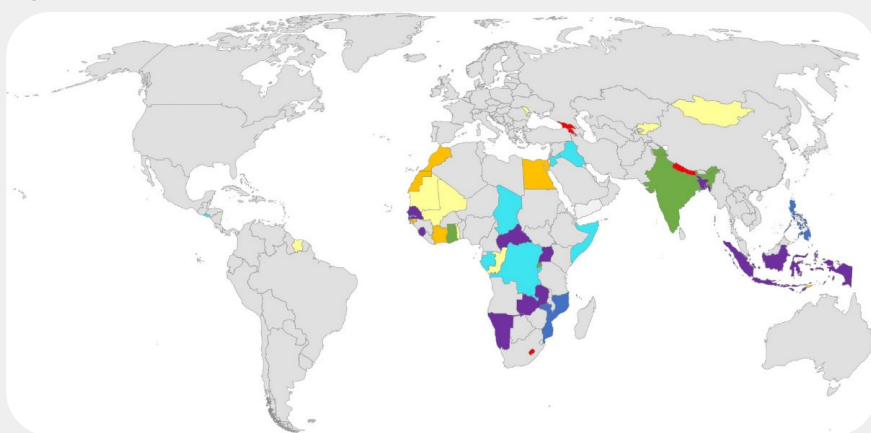
**2/5** of work plan implemented

- **1/2** of CD activities benefitted AFR
- **1/2** of fragile states benefitted from CD activities
- **4/6** of extended list of beneficiary countries received CD (*El Salvador, Indonesia, Mongolia, Namibia*)

• **TA Missions** | **46** TA missions benefitting **42** countries

**Ad-Hoc Advisory Services** | **29** interventions benefitting **17** countries

• **Regional Workshops** | **8** workshops benefitting **196** representatives from **40** countries

# Results-Oriented Final Implementation (Examples)

## SIERRA LEONE

- **D4D mission (May 2024):** Assist authorities in compiling the final version of the **2018 employment and remuneration matrices (ERM)** by economic activity, category of employment, and gender, including non-observed activities.
- **Objectives:**
  - Provide Training on ERM annual series, **sharing methodology guidelines**, and assisting with new statistical sources.
  - Follow key recommendations of the **2008 System of National Accounts**.
  - Suggest designing and collecting a permanent/continuous **household survey** on an annual basis to strengthen basic statistics and **improve national accounts estimates**.
- **Outcomes:**
  - **Completion of the final version of the 2018 ERM**, including previously missing data from the labor demand side.
  - Use of the preliminary ERM as an **input in the Supply and Use Tables** and in estimating the actual **Gross Domestic Product** for the base year 2018.



## CEMAC REGION

- **D4D Missions (Nov 2023 - Oct 2024):** Conducted by the Resident Advisor on External Sector Statistics **across CEMAC and non-CEMAC countries** (Burundi, Sao Tome and Principe, Democratic Republic of Congo).
- **Objective:**
  - Enhancements in External Sector Statistics framework, **focusing on data periodicity, timeliness, coverage, and reliability**.
- **Outcome:**
  - **Published Statistics: Annual Balance of Payments (BOP)** statistics for 2022 published on **BEAC-HQ website for all member countries**.

  - **Updates: Equatorial Guinea** updated BOP statistics through **2023**; updates for **Chad, Gabon, Republic of Congo, and Central African Republic** expected by **mid-2025**.



## CÔTE D'IVOIRE

- **D4D mission (Nov 2024):** Assist authorities in compiling data from financial statements and trial balances in accordance with the **2014 Government Finance Statistics Manual**.
- **Objectives:**
  - Enhance the coverage of Government Finance Statistics and Public Sector Debt Statistics (PSDS) by including major **State-Owned Enterprises**. Additional training delivered on the compilation and dissemination of PSDS to build capacity and improve fiscal and debt statistics.
  - Assist the authorities in meeting commitments under the **Extended Fund Facility/Economic and Financial Program** for 2023-2026.
- **Outcome:**
  - These efforts contributed to **greater transparency and quality of fiscal statistics**, supporting informed economic decision-making and fiscal risk assessment.

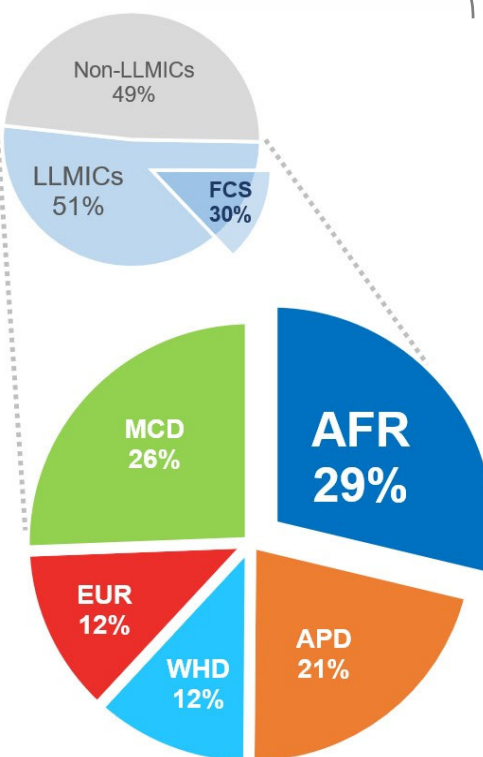
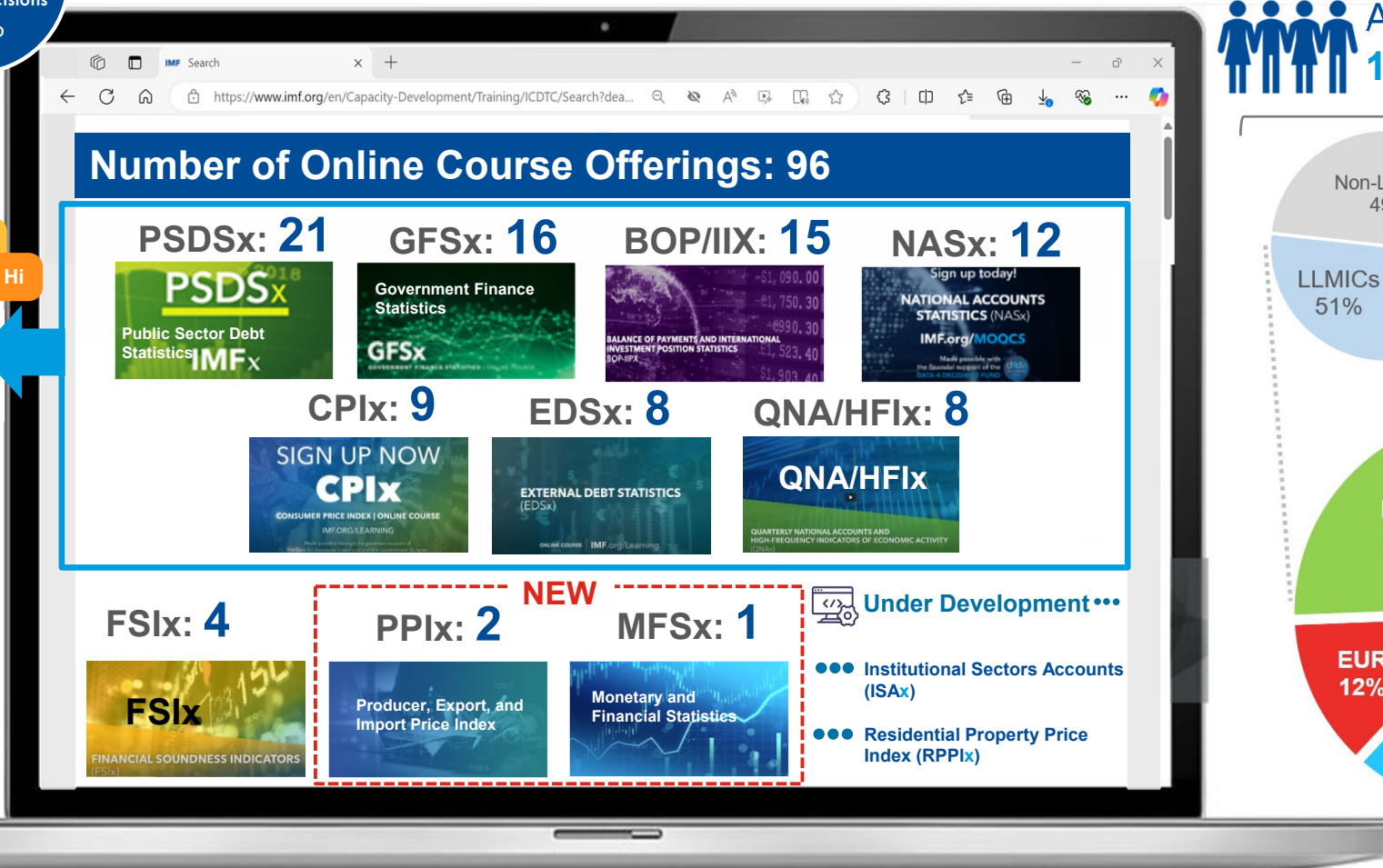

The Financial Access Survey (FAS) reporting continues to expand, providing valuable insights about financial inclusion and inclusive growth.

Number of country reporters to the FAS database

<b>Total reporters:</b>	168	→	<b>192</b>
 <b>Gender data reporters</b>	83	→	<b>89</b>
 <b>Mobile money reporters</b>	80	→	<b>83</b>

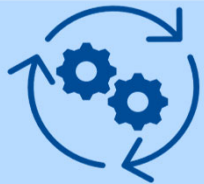
