PRESS STATEMENT

Today, Ms. Svetlana Cerović, IMF Resident Representative in the Republic of Moldova, made the following statement:

“An International Monetary Fund (IMF) mission, led by Ms. Alina Iancu, will visit Chişinău from May 7 to 20, 2026. The mission will hold discussions with the authorities following their request for a new arrangement under the Policy Coordination Instrument (PCI)¹. It will take stock of recent economic developments, update the assessment of the macroeconomic outlook and risks, and discuss policy and reform priorities with the authorities and other key stakeholders.”

¹ The [Policy Coordination Instrument \(PCI\)](#) is a non-financing instrument open to all IMF member countries. It enables a closer dialogue with countries and the endorsement of policies by the IMF, which allows them to signal commitment to reforms and to catalyze financing from other sources.
