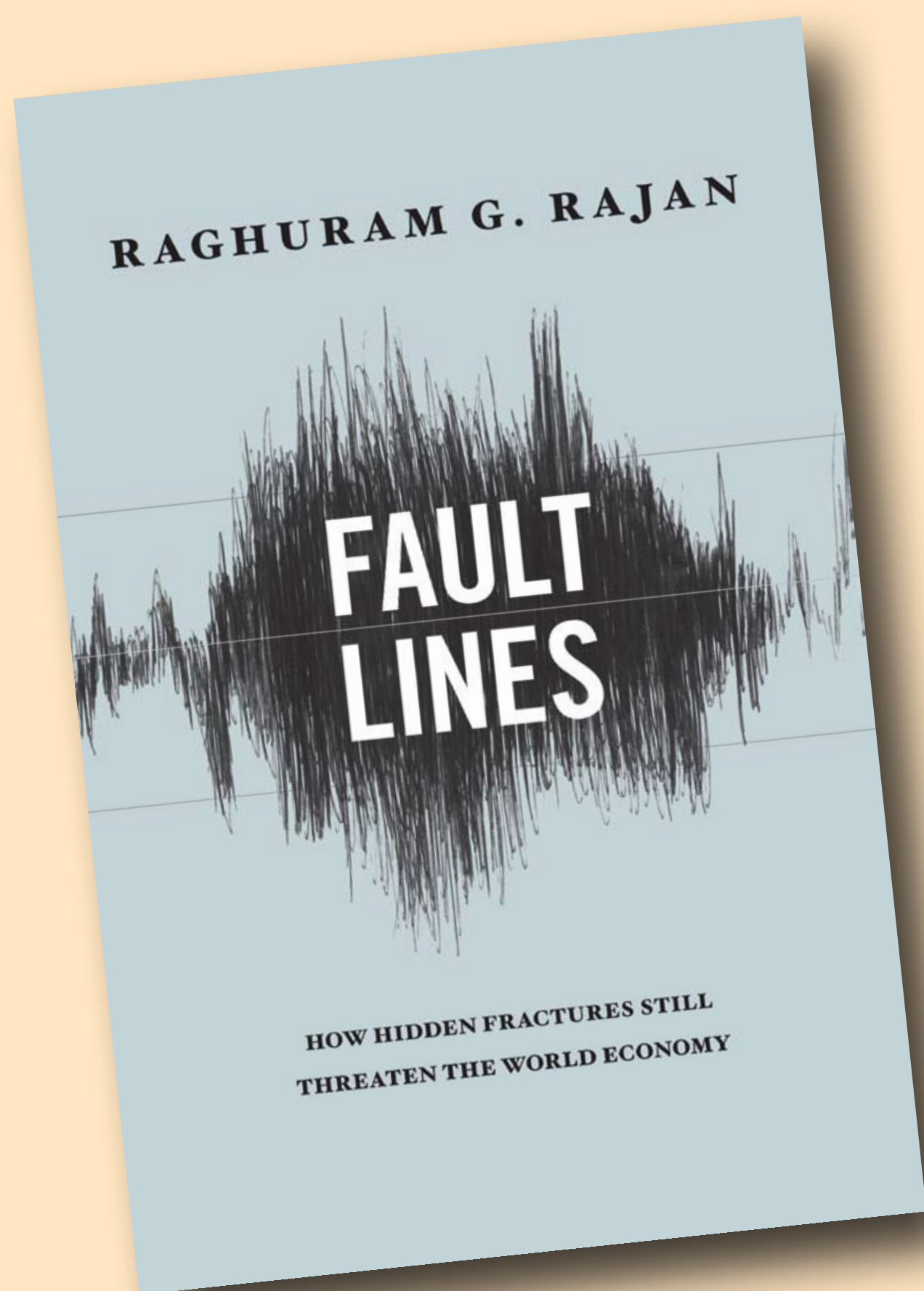

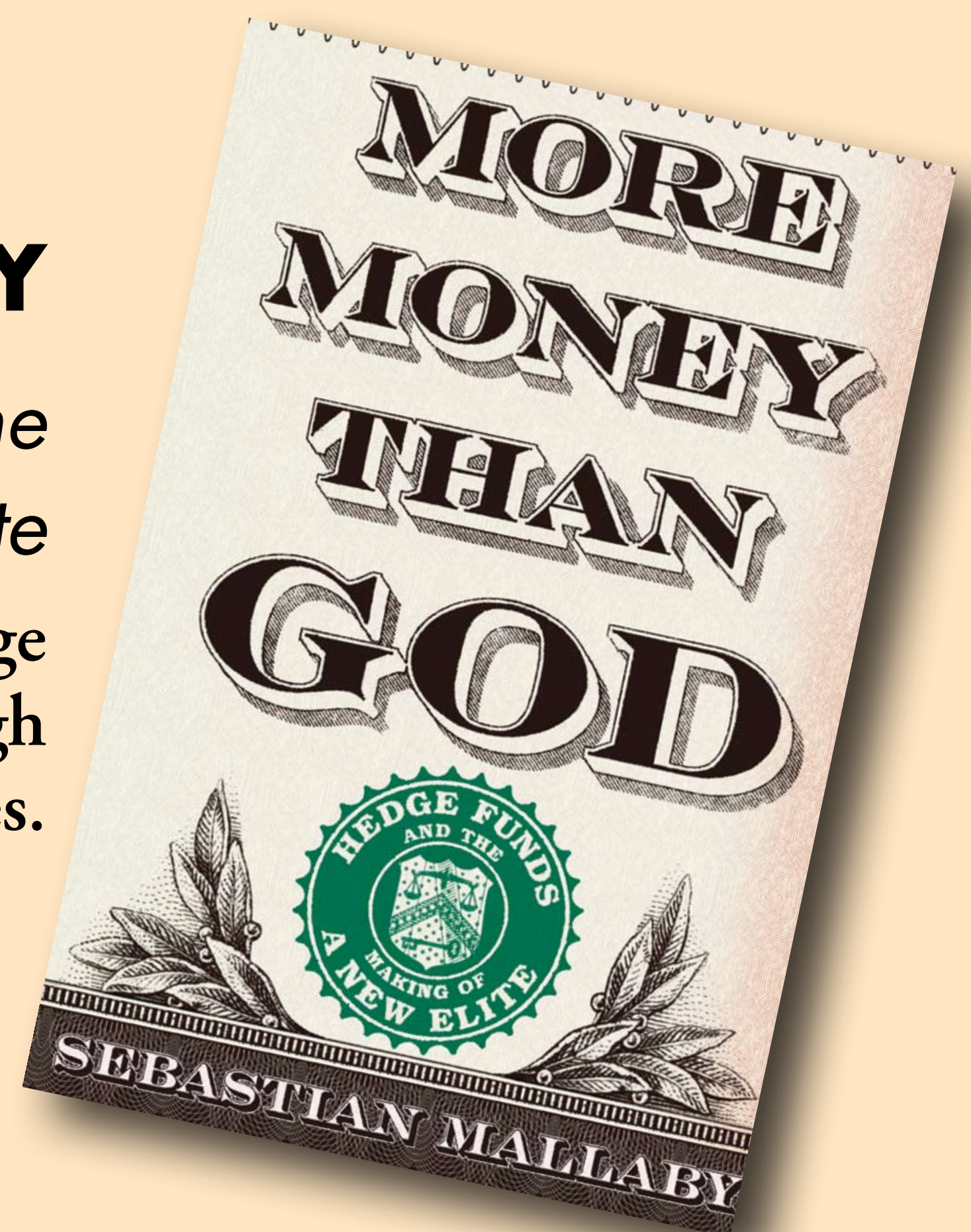
Fault Lines: How Hidden Fractures Still Threaten the World Economy
