- **Sessions with the IMF** on: global economic developments and challenges; the impact of the global financial and economic crisis on international financial architecture and governance; the IMF's work in lower-income countries; and challenges to global cooperation.
- **Sessions with the World Bank** on: the recent findings of the *World Development Report 2012: Gender Equality and Development*; solicit early input into the *World Development Report 2013: Jobs and Rethinking Growth Strategies*; and on private sector development and the business environment.

The themes of the Parliamentary Workshop have been defined in consultation with the Parliamentary Network (PNoWB), the World Bank's and IMF's partner in organizing this event.
