# MAIN CHANGES FROM THE *GFSM 2001*-BASED QUESTIONNAIRE AND DIFFERENCES BETWEEN VERSION 1.4 AND 1.5

### A. Cover Page

Compared to the 2001 questionnaire, the GFSM 2014-based questionnaires ask for more detailed metadata. These mainly relate to:

- Basis of recording: Cash versus Non-cash
- Method of recording investment in nonfinancial assets: Gross versus net
- Valuation of assets and liabilities

In the new version 1.5, we have added color coding to identify more clearly which cells should be completed, and added some core validation checks and checklists – all these should be green before data is submitted.

#### **B.** Statements and Tables

The GFSM-2014 based Questionnaire expanded the number of Statements and Tables compared to the 2001 questionnaire, however version 1.5 of the Questionnaire is less detailed than version 1.4.

Version 1.5 of the *GFSM 2014*-based Questionnaire includes 4 Statements; and 12 Tables. Annex 1 and Annex 2 are no longer requested, and the number of rows in some tables has been significantly reduced, in particular in tables 4, 5 and 9 which now only require summary data.

#### C. Institutional Coverage

The GFSM 2014-based questionnaire introduces a shift in the coverage of the central government. More specifically, the coverage of the central government in the GFSM 2014 questionnaire now excludes social security funds, which are recorded as a separate subsector of the general government. However, a memorandum column is included in the questionnaire, where the GFSM 2001 aggregate of the central government that includes social security funds is presented.

## D. Data Included in the GFSM 2014-based Questionnaire

While the classification of the GFS items remains largely the same under GFSM 2014 as in the previous GFSM 2001 questionnaire, there are some changes In addition, some tables now include an expanded list of GFS items, where others have dropped some GFS items. Version 1.5 of the questionnaire no longer requires a number of items requested in last year's version.
